



MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Requirements for Acceptance into the NABA Group

- A minimum of two years in the retail archery business with a store front.
- A minimum of \$200,000 in gross sales during the past year.
- Good credit (NABA does a simple third party credit check with: www.ircsystems.com and requires a minimum of four (4) "credit references" completed on the application form).
- Two pictures of your retail business.
- Established business hours and open a minimum of five (5) days per week.
- A completed application form and check for \$200 to cover the annual membership dues.
- Yearly dues will be \$200, payable upon approval and acceptance by the Board of Directors of the NABA.
- All members are required to attend one of the annual trade shows. The National Archery Buyers Association Trade Show held in Reno, Nevada, or in conjunction with the ATA Show.
- Each member will be solely responsible for their own credit applications and accounts with the manufacturer/vendor. Any member who falls delinquent with their accounts agrees to accept a "probationary status" (C.O.D. with all NABA Vendors) until such time as said account is made current.
- Each member agrees that should they be unable to correct the probationary status, they will accept termination from the NABA.
